TOOLS REQUIRED

Standard wrench set Torque wrench QUANTITY 1 1 DESCRIPTION Rock Crawler Tube Hardware Kit

Standard socket set Ratchet

1. Install the Warn Rock crawler tube to the Warn front bumper using the hardware provided. Insert a 7/16" bolt through the tube mounting plate, top of the bumper and install a flat washer and lock nut in each of the six locations. See Figure 1. Torque the 7/16" hardware to 50 lb. ft. (67.8 N-m).
