V. INSTALLATION

1. Install skid plate to front bumper

Mount the skid plate to the Warn front bumper using the 5 holes in the bottom of the bumper and the 5 holes in the skid plate.




Figure 1: Skid Plate bolt locations

Mount the skid plate to the factory blocker beam using the outer holes on each side of the blocker beam. **See Figure 1**.

Once all of the skid plate bolts are installed, torque all of the bolts to their proper torque.

VI. MAINTENANCE/CARE

1. Inspect all nuts and bolts on the winch, winch mount,, and related hardware prior to each use. Tighten all nuts that appear to be loose. Stripped, fractured, or bent bolts or nuts need to be replaced.
