The installer must verify that the mounting kit does not interfere with the factory air bag sensors, which must not be relocated or modified in any way. The vehicles air bag system may not operate properly if the winch mounting kit is not mounted in compliance with the vehicle manufacturers recommendations.

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Place vehicle on a flat surface and set emergency brake.
- 2. Remove the 2 plastic pins on the top of the front bumper cover between the bumper and grill and the clips holding the trim piece to the bumper. See Photo 1.
- 3. Remove the two 6mm screws from the factory lower skid plate. See Photo 2.





- 4. Unplug the fog light wiring harness on the passenger side as shown in Photo 3.
- 5. Remove the 4 bolts on each side using a 18mm socket and remove the bumper from the vehicle. See Photo 4 & 5.





6. Remove the factory crash bar as shown in **Photo 6** using a 16mm socket.







- 7. Install the hawse or roller fairlead and winch on the bumper using the hardware from the winch kit.
- 8. Install the LED light bar in the light mount and the flush mount LED lights in the bumper. Hardware with those kits will be used to install those lights.
- 9. Install the supplied flag nuts plates and secure them to the bumper using the plastic retainers only on the top holes of the bumper. 2 per side. See Photo 7.
- 10. Install the bumper in the factory mounting locations and secure with the supplied 12mm washers and nuts using a 18mm socket. Do not fully tighten at this time to allow bumper to be adjusted. **See Photo 8.**





- 11. Install the lower bolts in the bumper. See Photo 9. Do not fully tighten bolts.
- 12. Install the lower skid plate brackets to the frame as shown in Photo 10 for the JL model and as shown in Photo 11 for the JK model. with the supplied 8mm button head bolts, washers and nuts. Tighten hardware using a 6mm allen wrench and 13mm wrench.



- 13. Install the skid plate to the brackets with the supplied 8mm button head bolts, washers and nuts. See Photo 12.
- 14. Center bumper on vehicle and tighten frame mount hardware using a 18mm wrench.





15. Secure the skid plate to the bumper with the supplied 8mm button head bolts, washers and nuts. See Photo 13.



MAINTENANCE INFORMATION

- 1. Failure to securely tighten all bolts on the winch bumper, winch, and fairlead can result in product failure, which may result in vehicle damage or operator injury. Check that all bolts are securely tightened prior to use.
- 2. Inspect all nuts and bolts on the winch, bumper, and related hardware prior to each use. Tighten all nuts that appear to be loose. Stripped, fractured, or bent bolts or nuts should be replaced.
- 3. Periodically check bolt for tightness.
