Tools Needed: 15mm Wrench 19mm Deep Well Socket 21mm Wrench 24mm Wrench Jack Jack Stand



FRONT INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Place vehicle in park and chock the rear wheels. Raise the front of the vehicle with a jack and secure a jack stand beneath each frame rail behind the front control arms. Ease the frame down onto the stands.
- 2. Remove the front tires/wheels, using a 19mm deep well socket.
- 3. Remove the brake line bracket from the lower control arm using a 15mm wrench.
- 4. Remove the lower control arms using 21mm and 24mm wrenches. Retain hardware for reuse. See Photo 1.
- 5. Install the adjustable lower control arm on the axle using the factory hardware. **Do not tighten at this time. See Photo 2**.



- 6. Install the flex joint end in the control arm pocket on the frame, using the factory hardware. **Do not tighten at this time. See Photo 3.**
- 7. Install the brake line bracket on the lower control arm using the factory hardware. Tighten using a 15mm wrench. **See Photo 4**.
- Reinstall the wheels and tires and lower the vehicle to the ground. Torque all arm hardware to factory specs. Note** Make sure flex joint housing is centered in mount before tightening jam nut. Should not be touching either side.**





POST INSTALLATION

- Check all fasteners for proper torque.
- Re-torque all fasteners after 500 miles and recheck after 1000 miles.
- Have a qualified alignment center realign the front end.
