INSTALLATION INSTRUCTONS

- 1. Chock the rear wheels and jack up the front of the vehicle and support the vehicle with jack stands so that the front wheels are off the ground. Remove the tires/wheels.
- 2. Remove the brake line from the strut using a 13mm socket. Retain stock hardware. See Photo 1.
- 3. Remove the ABS line from the knuckle. See Photo 2.





- 4. Remove the sway bar from the strut using a 15mm socket. Retain the stock hardware. See Photo 3.
- 5. Remove the lower strut bolts using a 21mm socket and wrench. See Photo 4.





- 6. Remove the upper strut nuts using a 15mm socket. See Photo 5.
- 7. Remove the strut from the vehicle. See Photo 6.








- 8. Install the new strut into upper mount of the vehicle. See Photo 7.
- 9. Secure the upper strut using the (3) supplied nuts. Snug the nuts using a 14mm socket. See Photo 8.






- 10. Install the lower strut bolts using a 21mm socket and wrench. See Photo 9.
- 11. Install the sway bar link into the strut mount. Using a 15mm socket. See Photo 10.





- 12. Install the brake line bracket onto the strut. Tighten using a 13mm socket. See Photo 11.
- 13. Install the brake line to the body mount using a 13mm socket. See Photo 12.
- 14. Connect the ABS line onto the knuckle.





- 15. Tighten the upper strut nuts using a 17mm socket.
- 16. Install the wheels and tires, lift the front of the vehicle up using a jack and remove the jack stands. Then lower the vehicle to the ground.
