
- 1. Remove the rear shocks from the upper and lower mounts. Retain hardware for reuse.
- 2. Un-clip the push pins holding the wiring harness to the underside of the bed. See Photo 1.
- 3. Using the current mounting hole, measure 2" (towards the inside of the truck) and mark. See Photo 2.







- 4. Using a 3/8" drill, carefully drill a new hole through the bed support only. See Photo 3.
- 5. Secure the wiring harness using a wire tie. See Photo 4.





- 6. Install the supplied Vertex 2.5 Shocks in the upper mounts using the factory hardware and 18mm wrenches.
- 7. 2005-2016 models will use the supplied 12mm ID sleeve in the lower mount and 2017-18 models will use the supplied 14mm ID sleeve in the lower mount.
- 8. Install the Vertex shock in the lower mount using the factory hardware and a 15mm wrench and a 19mm wrench.
- 9. Torque all hardware to factory specs.
