Check and retighten wheels at 50 miles and again at 500 miles. Periodically check all hardware for tightness. Be sure you have all the needed parts and understand where they go. Also, please review the "Tools Needed" list to be certain you have the necessary tools to complete the installation.

Front Installation

- 1. Park your vehicle on a clean flat surface, engage the parking brake and block the rear tires.
- 2. Save all hardware removed from the vehicle unless otherwise noted.
- 3. Open the hood and disconnect the negative terminal on the battery.
- 4. The nudge bar brackets are designed for use with the Rough Country offset tow hook brackets for nudge bar options if you are wanting to run a shackle mount. They will not work with the Rough Country or any other standard tow hook bracket. You can use them with the stock tow rings by using the provided hardware and spacers. Remove the factory tow rings or brackets using a 17mm socket. Photo 1 / 2





- 5. If you are reusing the factory tow rings, you will need to use the provided 12mm x 65mm long bolts, washers and spacers. Driver side shown. **Photo 3**
- 6. Install the tow ring, spacers and bracket to the frame. Snug up the hardware, but leave loose at this time for adjustment. Driver side shown. **Photo 4**





- If you are using the Rough Country offset tow hook brackets, you can reuse the hardware that came off the truck, or you can use the provided 12mm short bolts and washers. The tow hook bracket will be offset to the middle of the truck. Passenger side shown. Photo 5
- 8. Install the offset tow hook bracket and nudge bar bracket to the frame. Snug up the hardware, but leave loose at this time for adjustment. Passenger side shown. **Photo 6**





Install lights of choice onto the nudge bar using the hardware provided with the light kits. If you are using the 20" light bar, you will need to install the light bar mount to the nudge bar using the provided 8mm bolts, washers, and flange nuts. Photo 7 / 8





- 10. Lay the nudge bar on its face and install the bracket as shown. Photo 9
- 11. Install the light bar using the hardware provided in the light kit. If you are using the 20" non DRL light bar, you may need to use the provided spacers and longer hardware included with the light bar. Snug up the light hardware for the light option you have chosen. **Photo 10**





- 12. Use of an assistant will aid in the next step as the install can be awkward to hold while trying to line up the holes for hardware. Install the nudge bar to the brackets making sure the brackets are on the outside of the nudge bar mount. Install using the provided 10mm bolts, washers, and flange nuts. Snug this hardware, but do not fully tighten. Photo 11
- 13. Torque the tow hook mounting hardware to 45ft-lbs. Once that is done, set the angle of the nudge bar to the desired vertical position and torque the 10mm hardware to 35ft-lbs. Run electrical to suit. Reconnect the negative battery terminal. **Photo 12**
