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GENERAL CARE AND MAINTENANCE

By choosing an ARB Rock Slider, you have bought a product that is one of the most sought after 4WD products in the world. Your rock slider is a properly engineered, reliable, quality accessory that represents excellent value. To keep your rock slider in original condition it is important to care and maintain it following these recommendations:

- Prior to exposure to the weather your rock slider should be treated to a Carnauba based polish on all exposed surfaces. It is recommended that this is performed on a six monthly basis or following exposure to salt, mud, sand or other contaminants.
- As part of any Pre Trip Preparation, or on an annual basis, it is recommended that a thorough visual inspection of the rock slider and surrounding components is carried out, making sure that all bolts are torqued to the correct specification. Also check that nearby wiring and plumbing are free of damage. Replace any components as necessary. This service can be performed by your local authorized ARB Stockist.

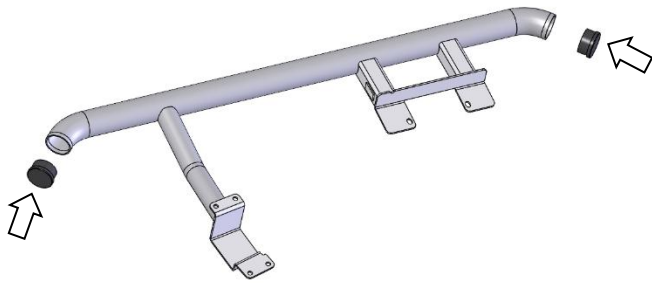

FITTING PROCEDURE – PREPARATION TO VEHICLE

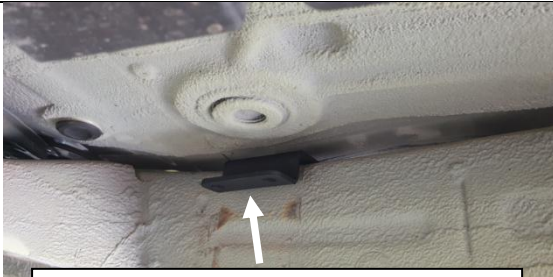


Install Rubber Plugs
RH Shown, LH Opposite

1. Install Rubber Plugs into both ends of the Rock Sliders as shown.



2. Identify 3752394 L&R. These will need to be positioned on top of chassis prior to fitting Rock Sliders



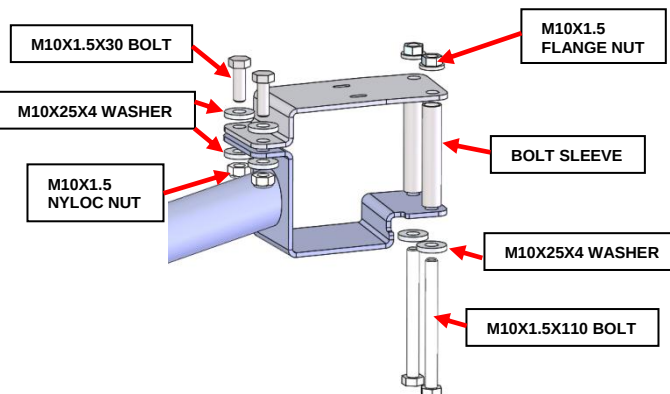
Return fold faces towards outside of vehicle

3. Slide brackets between chassis and floor of vehicle in the positions shown. Note the RHS bracket hangs over the brake lines (on RHD vehicles)

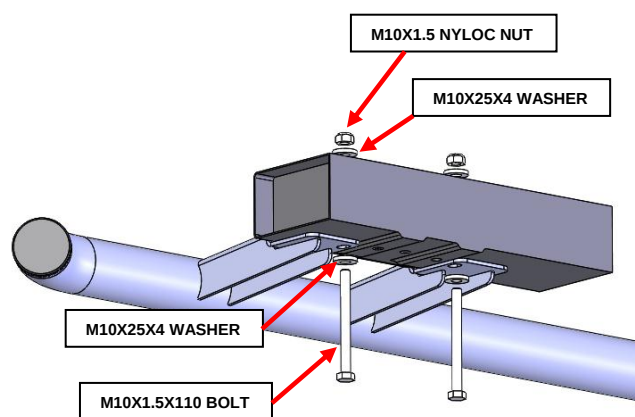




4. With the aid of somebody holding the rock slider in place or the use of axle stands, install fasteners into the front mount by hand as shown



5. Install fasteners into rear mount by hand as shown



ADJUST SO THERE IS NO GAP HERE

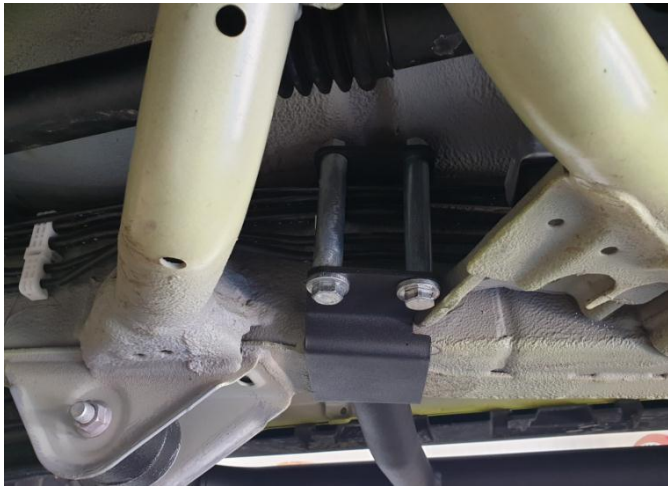
6. Tighten all bolts to specified torque. When tightening the rear mount, ensure that the vertical face is hard against the chassis as shown.

7. Rock Slider should look like this



8. The RHS Rock Slider front mount sits over the vehicle brake lines. **Ensure you don't damage the brake lines during installation**

9. Fit decal to plastic sill trim
